

Booking Conditions for in-Studio Classes

1. A full refund will be offered after the first week in the unlikely event that a participant does not find the course content to their satisfaction. After this first week, fees for the semester are non-refundable.
2. Centauri Arts Academy is a no smoking facility. Smoking in the Studio, or in the communal courtyard area is not permitted.
3. Centauri reserves the right to remove from arts activities any participant whose behaviour becomes detrimental to the experience of others, or whose actions place themselves or others at risk. In such cases, the parent will be notified. Repeat behaviour of an antisocial, dangerous or unacceptable nature may result in expulsion from the program. Such decisions are at the sole discretion of the directors. No refund will be given.
4. Some programs at the Arts Academy (for Grades 6-12 only) involve activities out of the Academy studio. Examples may include film groups shooting on location in the neighbourhood. In sending your son or daughter to us, you recognise this may be a feature of the program. General supervision will be provided (for example, the film instructor may be within contact while two film groups shoot nearby). If we intend to take a group out of the immediate neighbourhood (to attend a poetry reading, for example) parents will always be notified by email one week prior to the event.
5. Arts Academy Participants will be permitted to leave the Studio unaccompanied at the end of each session unless requested otherwise by a parent.
6. Should a program lack sufficient enrolment to proceed, the participants already registered will be offered a choice of either a space on a different program or a full refund. Centauri's liability shall then cease.
7. If a class must be cancelled for reasons beyond our control - for example, inclement weather - no makeup class can be provided. However, in the case of instructor illness, if a substitute teacher is unavailable, where possible, we will increase the length of three subsequent classes to compensate for the lost time. If the instructor is ill for two or more sessions, and a substitute teacher is unavailable, then refunds will be offered for those sessions.
8. If a student is unable to attend a class for any reason, no make-up class can be offered.

- Film Production and Performance Program: Confidentiality Waiver –

Making and sharing a short film leads to the public acknowledgement of contributions made by the young people who participate. Names are published as credits at the end of the movie, and the movie may be shared again by others online, featured on YouTube or distributed informally on social media. Marketing a short movie may result in the public distribution of the names of young artists involved with the project, and the movie may be listed on IMDb, or details about the movie shared in further ways. In signing below, you recognise that the full name of

contributors to short movies made by Centauri Arts' film classes may enter the public domain, along with any other information freely provided by contributors for the purpose of promoting their movie – such as headshots, or biographies. Your signature indicates that you agree your child's name may be attached to the movies created by their group, and that the movie may enter the public domain in the ways described above.

9. All in-studio academy participants are required to follow safety measures mandated by public health and requested by Centauri Arts for the duration of COVID. Refusal to do so will result in a request to leave the academy space at which point parents will be notified. Repeated failure to comply with COVID safety regulations will result in removal from the course. A refund will only be given if we can fill your space from a waiting list.
